- Type of Entries:

Marching Units (other than high school bands) will be judged on showmanship, quality of routine and crowd appeal. Open to any unit marching on foot and can be something any creative group can easily form. The parade must be kept moving so as not to create large "gaps" along the route. Design a routine that keeps your group moving.

Floats: The judging scores will be decided by combining the scores from three areas:

<u>Creative Use of Theme</u>	<u>Construction</u>	<u>Details</u>
Depicts the parade's theme	Quality of workmanship	Parade theme
Use of new and innovative ideas	Use of materials	Creativity
Crowd appeal	Amount of work involved	Animation

Company vehicles are not allowed in the parade unless they are pulling a float. The parade audience remembers those businesses or organizations that take the time to show their pride by making a fantastic float.

Novelty Entries are any entries not included in the marching units or floats.

- Candy / Paper For safety purposes, nothing is to be thrown from moving vehicles. Walkers may hand out candy and promo items. Do not plan to hand out any brochures, coupons or other paper items, as most of this is left behind for us to clean up.
