## Rules:

1. Size – all photographs must be mounted on an 11” by 14” mat board. The photographs may be any size up to 11” by 14”.
2. Photographic Media – there will be no distinction made between photographs produced digitally or through traditional photographic processes.
3. Mounting – all photographs must be mounted and unframed. There should be no hooks or wires attached. **Do NOT cover photos with acetate or glass or attach any material other than labels to the back.** NOTE: Mounting or mat must be 11” by 14”.
4. Identification – Photographer’s name and picture title should NOT appear on the front of the entry.
5. Eligibility – Photographs previously designated award winners at the Pufferbilly Days™ Photo Contest are not eligible for entry.
6. Reproduction – The Pufferbilly Days™ Steering Committee reserves the right to reproduce in any form any of the work submitted.
7. Limit of 6 entries per person.
